TASTING NOTES

Rocche Costamagna Barolo Rocche dell'Annunziata 2020. This 100% Nebbiolo is from a single vineyard plot consisting of chalky soils from the Rocche dell'Annunziata cru which is one of the most prestigious vineyards in La Morra. The wine undergoes fermentation and a maceration for around 3 weeks, and then aged for 18 months in large oak barrels. The result is a refined and elegant red that is intense and complex nose and a palate with sweet tannins.
