Bussola Tommaso Valpolicella Classico 2023. This is a light Italian red vinified in stainless steel to preserve freshness, with a short maturation of 4â€"6 months in steel tanks before bottling. Aromas of red cherry, violet, and subtle spice lead to a light, juicy palate with soft tannins.
