Etna Bianco Superiore 2024. From the high-altitude vineyards of Miloâ€™s Contrada Villagrande at 700 meters, this Etna Bianco is composed of 90% Carricante with a touch of other native varieties and fermented in stainless steel. This Etna reveals delicate aromas of white flowers and orchard fruit. The palate is crisp and vibrant, marked by lively acidity and a clean mineral backbone that brings precision and finesse.
