Baron di Villagrande Etna Rosso 2023. Reflecting the elegance and character of the volcanic terroir of Milo and Castiglione di Sicilia, this wine is crafted primarily from Nerello Mascalese with a touch of Nerello Cappuccio and Nerello Mantellato, it undergoes fermentation in steel with a short maceration period, followed by a year of maturation in traditional chestnut barrels. The wine showcases its youthful vibrancy and refined structure. Its aromatic profile is layered with floral nuances and subtle earthy undertones, complemented by delicate herbal hints. This vintage embodies balance and complexity.
