




Nebbiolo (Italian), or Nebieul (Piedmontese) is a red Italian wine grape variety predominantly associated with the Piedmont region where it makes the Denominazione di Origine Controllata e Garantita (DOCG) wines of Barolo, Barbaresco, Gattinara and Ghemme. Nebbiolo is thought to derive its name from... Read More

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TASTING NOTES

Rocche Costamagna Barolo DOCG 2020. Crafted entirely from Nebbiolo and matured for 18 months in oak, presents ruby red colour with garnet hues. The Nebbiolo grapes came from 70% La Mora and 30% Borduno yet still a single vineyard vintage. With this balance and structure, the wine has fresh acidity with firm and dry tannins. This wine is good to drink now, or to age for up to 15 years.
