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## TASTING NOTES

Jean-Marie Haag Les Trois Terres 2023. This is a wine that displays depth and refinement. The nose is full and expressive, bursting with noble aromas of yellow fruits, white peach, and delicate smoky notes. The palate is rich, with heady texture and full-bodied character. A touch of sweetness is balanced by fresh vibrancy, layered with toasty nuances and flavors of ripe pear, leading to a long, satisfying finish.
