TASTING NOTES

Bolney Lychgate Bacchus 2023. Bright and zesty, this vintage finishes clean and refreshing, with vibrant acidity that enhances its crisp character. The grapes were hand-picked, followed by whole-bunch pressing to preserve aromatic purity. The wine was fermented in stainless steel tanks over approximately 14 days, a process designed to retain fresh fruit flavours and aromatic intensity.
