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TASTING NOTES

Domaine Derame Muscadet Sevre et Maine Sur Lie 2023. This is a crisp, mineral-driven white made from 100% Melon de Bourgogne. Fermented in stainless steel and aged on fine lees for several months, it offers subtle citrus and saline aromas with a delicate biscuit nuance. The palate is fresh and textured, with bright acidity and a clean, lingering finish.
