Wakefield Wines Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 2021. With grapes from Limestone Coast and Clare Valley, this wine offers a classic Cabernet structure with fine tannins and balanced intensity. Aged for up to 10 months in French oak, it combines ripe blackcurrant fruit with subtle oak complexity with a rounded mouth feel. Enjoy now or cellar for medium-term ageing.
