Canalicchio di Sopra Brunello di Montalcino Montosoli DOCG 2019. This Brunello di Montalcino from the Montosoli cru shows remarkable elegance and depth, with vibrant aromas of red cherry, wild berries, and subtle floral notes layered over hints of spice and minerality. On the palate, it is structured yet refined, offering purity of fruit, lively acidity, and a long, vertical finish that speaks to its terroir and ageing potential.
