### TASTING NOTES

Rocche Costamagna Langhe Nebbiolo 2024. This wine is steeped in history and embodies the significance of Rocche Costamagna. The estate crafts approximately 30,000 bottles annually, and demand has been steadily growing. Aromas of wild berries and florals lead the nose, followed by a palate framed by delicate tannins. This wine is fermented in stainless steel for roughly ten days, then partially aged in oak barrels.
