## TASTING NOTES

Francois Villard Les Contours de Mairlant 2023. Produced in the northern Rh ne Valley, this still white wine reflects the estate's commitment to expressing terroir and natural balance. This white opens with an inviting bouquet of ripe stone fruits, citrus zest, and subtle floral notes, underpinned by a gentle minerality. On the palate, it is fresh and well-rounded, offering flavors of peach, apricot, and hints of almond, with a lively acidity that gives structure and elegance. The finish is long and harmonious, showcasing the purity of fruit and finesse typical of Villard's style.
